Dear Parent/ Guardian:

On June 13, 2019, Governor Andrew Cuomo signed into law legislation (S.2994A/A.2371) repealing the provision permitting a religious exemption of the vaccination requirements for students. This means that **ALL** school children must now be vaccinated as required by the Public Health Law, even if their parents have religious objections to the vaccinations. The new legislation is effective immediately.

Pursuant to Public Health Law 2164, every student entering or attending public school must be immunized. Public school students must be immunized against poliomyelitis, mumps, measles, diphtheria, rubella, varicella, hepatitis B, pertussis, tetanus, and where applicable, Haemophilus influenza type b, pneumococcal disease, and meningococcal disease. The required immunizations may be administered by any health practitioner, or at no cost by a county health officer upon parental consent. Estimado padre / guardián:

El 13 de junio de 2019, el gobernador Andrew Cuomo firmó la legislación de la ley (S.2994A/A.2371) se deroga la disposición que permita una exención religiosa de los requisitos de vacunación para los estudiantes. Esto significa que **todos** los niños de la escuela, ahora deben ser vacunados como requerido por la ley de salud pública, incluso si sus padres tienen objeciones religiosas a las vacunas. La nueva legislación es eficaz inmediatamente.

Según salud pública ley 2164, debe ser vacunado cada estudiante ingresar o asistir a escuelas públicas. Estudiantes de escuelas públicas deben ser vacunados contra la poliomielitis, paperas, sarampión, difteria, rubéola, varicela, hepatitis B, tos ferina, tétanos, y en su caso, Haemophilus influenza tipo b, neumococo y enfermedad meningocócica. Las inmunizaciones necesarias se pueden administrar por cualquier profesional de la salud, o sin costo por un oficial de salud del Condado al consentimiento de los padres.
