Today, Assemblywoman Kimberly Jean-Pierre released a formal public statement indicating that she has tested positive for COVID-19. I am writing to make you aware that the Assemblywoman visited the District on March 13, 2020. During her visit, she conducted a read-aloud with students at the Lafrancis Hardiman/Dr. Martin L. King Jr. Elementary School. At the time of her visit, the Assemblywoman was asymptomatic and since her visit, each building has undergone a thorough disinfecting and sanitizing pursuant to the guidelines of the Center for Disease Control for cleaning and the District's planned COVID-19 emergency response.

We are taking this situation extremely seriously and are working with the Suffolk County Health Department to navigate the issues relating to the potential exposure. We will keep you abreast as this situation develops and continue to ensure that the District follows the protocols and recommendations of the Department of Health in this regard.
